## how to make a biodiversity mobile

- 1. Colour and cut out the pictures of plants, animals, "me", and the title on the next page.
- 2. Glue the pictures onto coloured construction paper and cut around the outline of the pictures again. (Optional: select, cut out, and glue pictures of animals, plants, or people from magazines and glue them on the other side of the construction paper.)
- ${\it 3}$ . Using a hole punch, make a hole at the top of each picture cut out.
- 4. Punch 8 holes spread evenly around the edge of the paper plate or cardboard circle.
- 5. Cut lengths of string. Each string can be a different length of between 15 centimetres and 1 metre long.
- 6. Tie a knot around the hole in each picture. Tie the other end of each string into one of the holes in the paper plate or cardboard circle.
- Using a sharp pencil, punch a hole in the middle of the paper plate or cardboard circle. Using a sharp pencil, push a length of string through the hole. Tie a knot in the string on the same side as the pictures are hanging from. Now you can hang it up!
