## Mutually agreed terms (MAT)

Mutually Agreed Terms define, in an agreement between providers and users, conditions for the access to and the utilization of Genetic Resources as well as the sharing of benefits resulting from their Utilization in accordance with the Nagoya Protocol to the Convention on Biological Diversity.
